## Art Show Judges

Judging will be done by two Southern California independent judges that are non-members of the Yucaipa Valley Art Association. The judges for this year's Spring Art Show are Calvin Liang, an award-winning fine artist who has received many accolades for his art and Heidi Stangeland, an award-winning screen writer, photographer, and founder of a non-profit organization. For the show, blind art judging involves the review and selection process for awards with only titles of artwork and category numbers available for the judges to review on a sheet and on the corresponding art display. We look forward to congratulating the many artists who will receive ribbons and awards at this year's art show.

### Calvin Liang, Art Show Judge



Award-winning artist, Calvin Liang was born in Canton, China. He began painting in high school and completed his art education at the Shanghai Academy of Fine Arts, recognized as one of China's most prestigious and competitive art academies. In China, his skills as a fine artist were applied to the theatrical industry where he designed and created sets for operas and musical dramas for the Canton Opera Institute. Liang moved to the United States in 1987 and continued his profession as a full-time artist. He had a long and successful career creating visual art for the entertainment industry in animation, which included the Walt Disney Studios and Nickelodeon Studio. He decided to guit working for the

studios to pursue a full-time career as a fine artist, painting themes of his choosing. Since leaving his animation career in early 2002, Liang has been noticed. His accomplishments include winning many top awards in important exhibitions, including Award of excellence in the National Oil & Acrylic Painters' Society 32<sup>nd</sup> Best of America National Exhibition.

National art magazines also took notice of his art. In 2004, Liang's work graced the cover of Art of the West's special 16<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Edition. From 2006-2008, he had full feature articles in American Art Collector Magazine. Liang has been featured in many other prestigious artist magazines. From 2012-2015 he was selected into the Masters of the American West Fine Art Exhibition and Sale, at the Autry National Center in Los Angeles.

Calvin Liang is a Master Member of Oil Painters of America and American Impressionist Society, and a Signature Member of California Art Club and Laguna Plein Air Painters Association.

### Heidi Stangeland, Art Show Judge



As a Norwegian native, Heidi Stangeland is an optioned and award-winning screenwriter and the founder of the Hané Saga Filmmakers Conference. Stangeland has always had a passion for storytelling and has been writing stories from a young age while also exploring storytelling through photography.

Stangeland is known for crafting suspenseful atmospheric stories rooted in Nordic noir and science fiction. Drawing deeply from her Scandinavian heritage, she weaves elements of mythology and folklore into her narratives, creating richly layered tales that transcend border and genres. Before fully embracing her path as a writer, she apprenticed under commercial and fashion photographer in Kristiansand, Norway; an experience that sharpened her eye for detail and deepened her visual storytelling skills. In addition to her creative work, she is the founder of Hané Saga, a nonprofit organization dedicated to supporting and amplifying the voices of storytellers from diverse backgrounds.





### **About The Yucaipa Valley Art Association**

The Yucaipa Valley Art Association (YVAA) is a non-profit organization supporting the artistic endeavors of the local community. YVAA was established in 1981 with the mission to encourage and develop an appreciation for the arts and to further educate, inspire and enrich the lives of others through their programs and activities.

The Spring Art Show that is part of the Music and Arts Festival is held each year and the public and members are encouraged to exhibit their own artwork by entering the art show.

YVAA provides members and visitors an opportunity to participate and visually appreciate local artistic talent by holding monthly meetings. The organization holds various events and activities throughout the year to fundraise and to promote art and photography in the community. Throughout the year, they coordinate with local businesses and other organizations, such as The City of Yucaipa on art related events and displays.
